

WASHINGTON HUNTER EDUCATION AFFIDAVIT OF ONLINE CERTIFICATION

- Individuals taking the Washington Hunter Online Home Study Course must attain a minimum qualifying score of 80%.
- Individuals taking the Washington Hunter Online Home Study Course must complete testing without assistance from friends, family members, use of notes or written materials, etc. Use of any assistance in any form constitutes deliberate cheating.
- Any individual who cheats during any hunter education test shall be deemed to have failed the course.
- Any individual who falsifies a notarized statement is guilty of perjury.
- Any individual who fraudulently obtains a hunting license may be subject to additional penalties.

Directions for Completing the Notarized Affidavit of Certification Exam Score

1. Take this form, your Certification Exam certificate and your I.D. to a Notary Public in your area.
2. Explain that this form must be notarized before it is given to a hunter education instructor at a classroom / range evaluation session.
3. Print all information legibly in the presence of the Notary Public.
4. Sign the form only in the presence of the Notary Public.
5. Instruct the Notary Public to place his/her seal, signature and date in the lower right portion of the form.
6. Attach a copy of your Certification Exam certificate.
7. Give the notarized affidavit and an attached copy of your certification exam certificate to a hunter education instructor upon your arrival at the classroom/range evaluation session for which you have pre-registered.
